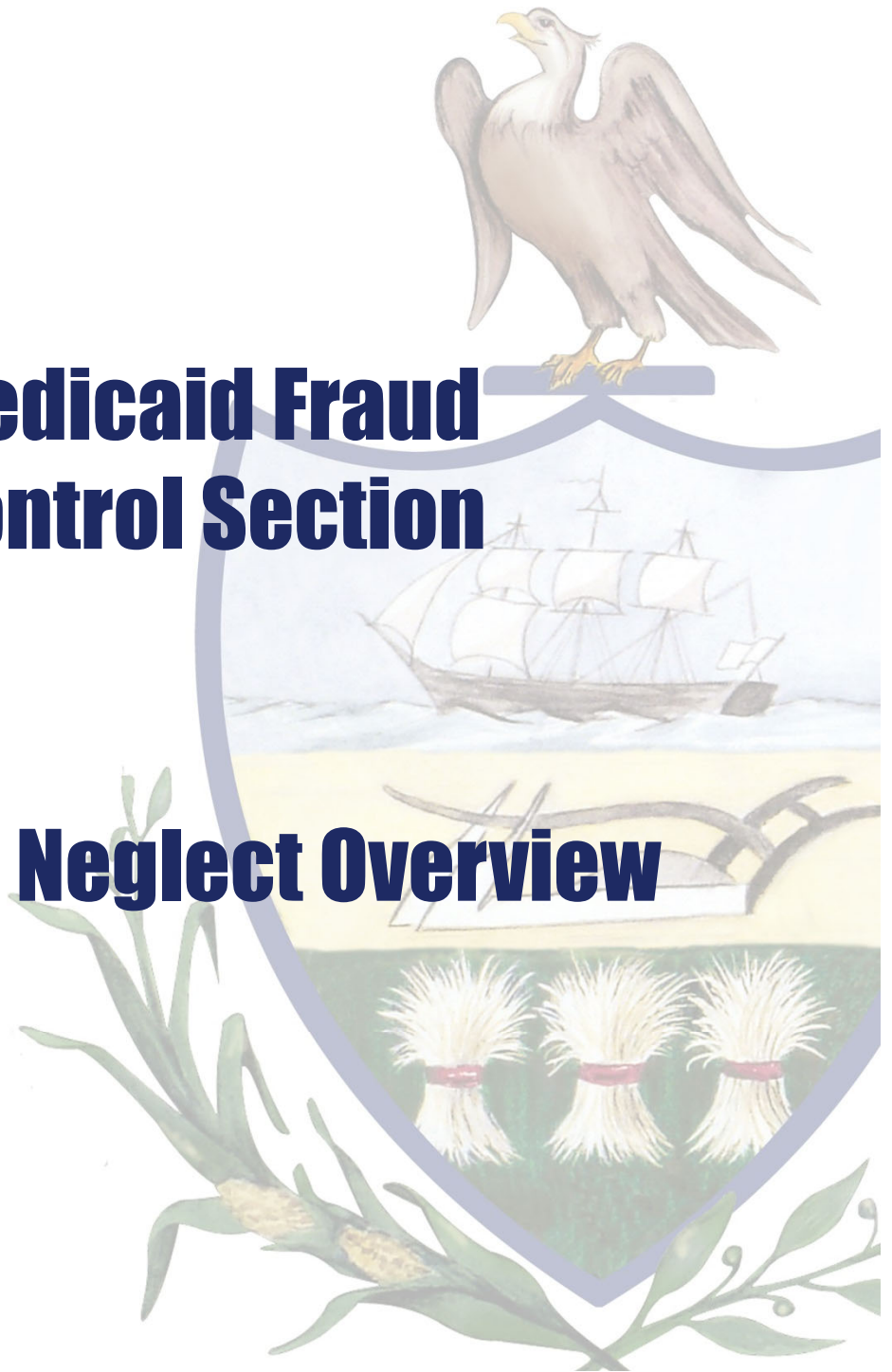

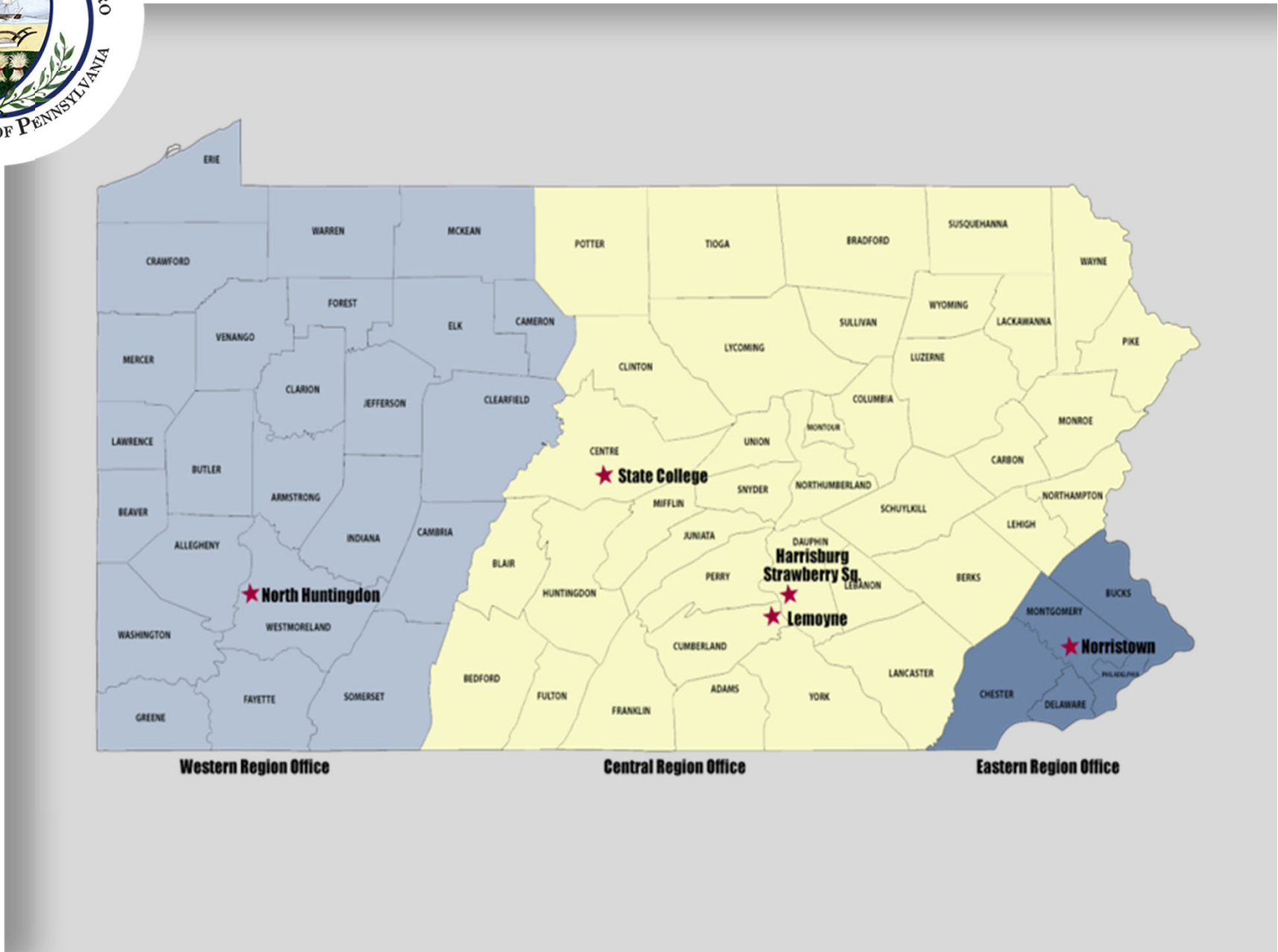

Medicaid Fraud Control Section (MFCS)

- We are a state Criminal Justice Agency funded by federal and state taxpayers whose mission is to protect the integrity of the Medical Assistance Program and care-dependent Pennsylvania citizens.
- The Section has investigative and prosecutorial power.

We Investigate and Prosecute:

- Crimes Authorized by the Commonwealth Attorneys Act
- Crimes Authorized by Statute:
 - Medicaid Fraud
 - Neglect of Care-Dependent Persons
- Crimes Arising From Authorized Investigations

We Investigate and Prosecute:

- Neglect of a Care-Dependent Person
- Crimes arising out of Neglect of a Care-Dependent Person investigations:
 - Homicide
 - Aggravated Assault
 - Abuse of a Care-Dependent Person
